




## A CHRISTMAS REWARD FOR OUR MEMBERS

## CHRISTMAS BIRD COUNT



Each year Christmas Bird Counts are conducted on a single day between December 14 and January 5, all over North America. Counts are carried out within a 24-km diameter circle that stays the same from year to year. The information collected by the thousands of volunteer participants forms one of the world's largest wildlife survey data sets. 121 years of Counts! The Saint. Andrews Christmas Bird Count has been conducted yearly since at

least 1961 and shows Mallard and Northern Cardinal numbers increasing, while House Sparrow and Common Eider numbers are declining.

If you feed the birds and can identify the species coming to your feeder and would like to help monitor North America's birds, please contact Tracey Dean at tdean@huntsmanmarine.ca to let her know your intention to participate and your address.

The procedure is simple: Pick a portion of the day (December 19th) and record how many of each species you see.


