#### **HOMESTYLE TAKE OUT DINNERS**

A Project of Shiretown Community Services

Shiretown Community Services. Inc. is a not-for-profit, charitable corporation in Saint Andrews that was set up in 2005. The organization has been reactivated, an Annual General Meeting held, and a Board of Directors elected.

The two immediate goals of the organization are

To provide opportunities for those in our community who encounter barriers to employment.

To provide a housing solution for the low-income segment of our population.



A pilot training program in connection with the first goal started the first week of March. Four individuals will be trained by a chef to do prep work of the sort done in restaurant kitchens. In addition to learning food service skills, participants will develop key skills in areas such as teamwork, communication, and problem solving while building confidence and self esteem in a nurturing and supportive environment. If the pilot project is successful, it will be further developed.

Under the pilot, the trainees will provide up to fifty take-out meals once a week for six weeks

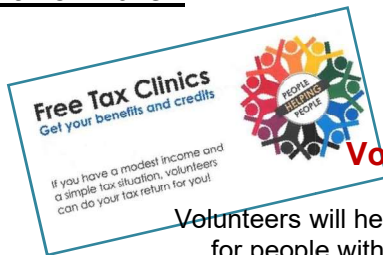
