We will discuss steps that are currently being taken to assist the Monarch Butterfly and what we can do to make a difference in their recovery.

There will be a demonstration and details of the monarch tagging program which I am participating in this year. We will discuss how you can join the tagging program, plant a butterfly friendly garden and the importance of the milkweed plant.

You will have the opportunity to plant milkweed seeds in a mini greenhouse made from a pop bottle which you can take home to plant in your garden in the spring.
