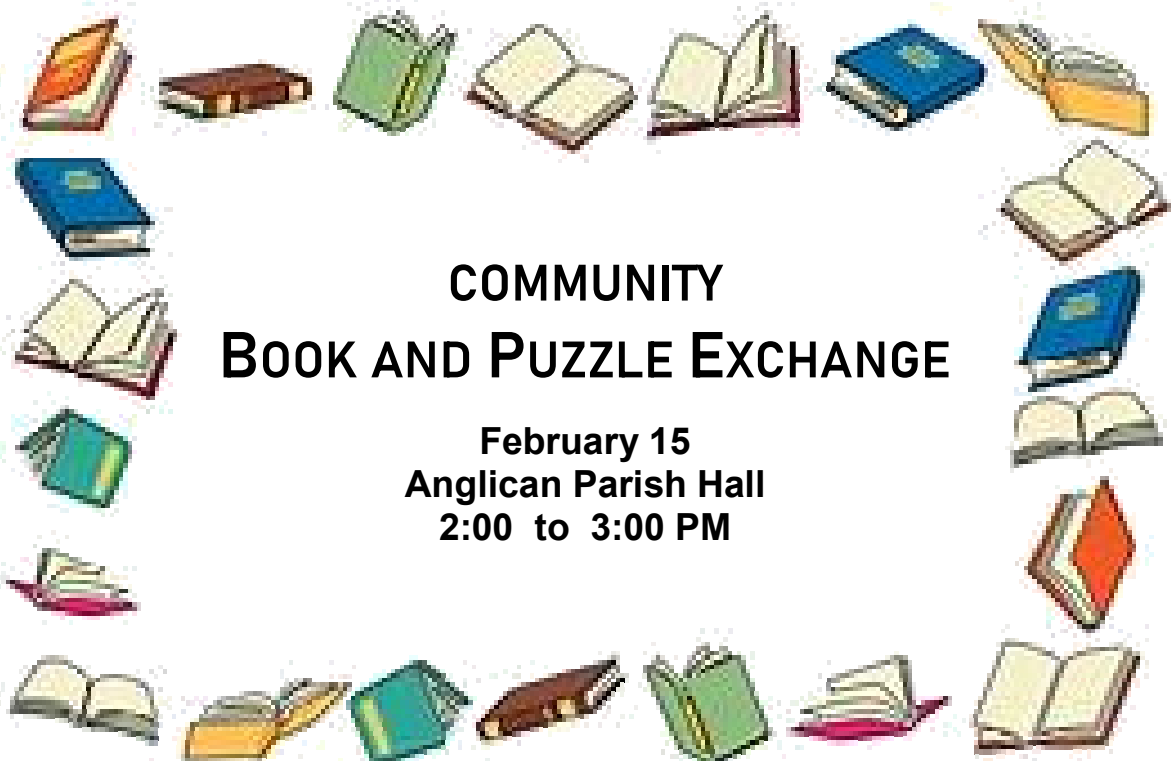
Local celebrity *Passamaquoddy Pete*, who saw his shadow on Groundhogs' Day, predicted six additional weeks of winter.
